ASSESSMENT METHOD	ASSESSMENT CRITERIA
Lab assignments (practical side of learning outcomes)	<p>Assessment criteria for lab assignments. Each student is given individual assignments. Lab work is given a passing grade if</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the assignment is done correctly (everything is working properly); • the results of the lab assignments are presented in written form (including any files generated and a detailed description of the methodology and results) • lab reports are submitted on time. <p>The lab assignments must have a passing grade and the lab report(s) will form 60% of the total grade (scale 1-5).</p>
Individual presentations (all learning outcomes)	<p>Assessment criteria of individual presentations. Each student must choose 4 topics for mini-reviews, on which they must report at seminars. Grades (scale 1-5) are based on the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - professional content (50%) - presentation style and ability to answer questions related to review (30%) - timing (20%) <p>The total score of mini-reviews gives 40% of the total grade.</p>
Written exam (all outcomes)	<p>The final grade consists of the lab report (60%) and the total score of mini-reviews (40%) presented during the semester. In addition, all the labs must be passed.</p>
PREREQUISITES FOR FINAL ASSESSMENT (EXAMINATION)	<p>Accepted labs and presentations.</p>
