

Evaluation criteria

Evaluation in Healthcare

1) Module 1 (25% of overall grade or 25 points), which consists of group work 100% aka 25 points.

2) Module 2 (25% of overall grade or 25 points), which consists of:

a. individual assignments (mini literature review, opponent review, poster presentation) (60% or 15 points) /

b. mixed assignments (group work, calculation exercises in seminars, preparation exercise, test) (40% or 10 points) /

3) Examination (50% of overall grade or 50 points).

The overall grade depends on what percentage of 100 points the student accumulates during the course. Student needs to gain 51% in both modules to be allowed to take the examination.

91% - 100% Grade "A", "Excellent" and pass

81% - 90% - Grade "B", "Very Good" and pass

71% - 80% - Grade "C", "Good" and pass

61% - 70% - Grade "D", "Average" and pass

51% - 60% - Grade "E", "Sufficient" and pass

0% - 50% - Grade "F", "Poor" and fail.
