<b>Practical works</b> <b>(evaluates the expected results 1,2)</b>	Practical works are passed if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• all the practical works are performed;</li> <li>• protocols of the practical works are reported on time;</li> <li>• protocols are formed according to the instructions;</li> <li>• protocols and practical works are orally defended.</li> </ul> Practical works are not passed if any of the following conditions are not filled.
<b>Exam</b> <b>(evaluates the expected results 1,2)</b>	There is an exam at the end of the course on the topics learned during the course. The exam consists of questions and test.  <b>The exam is being valued in 100 point scale.</b> Grade “1” – 51-60 points Grade “2” – 61-70 points Grade “3” – 71-80 points Grade “4” – 81-90 points Grade “5” – 91-100 points
<b>PRECONDITIONS FOR EVALUATION</b>	To take the final exam all the e-tests must be done, essay/presentation and practical works must be passed.
