

ASSESSMENT METHOD	ASSESSMENT CRITERION
Home assignments (KT)	<p>The students are expected to submit 3 home assignments. In order to receive maximum 25 points one should receive a “pass” grade from 2 out of 3 assignments.</p> <p>The “pass” grade requires that you try to answer, showing a base understanding of the question proposed, and the ability to choose the correct method in answering the question.</p>
Seminars (S)	<p>The students are expected to participate in two seminars. Seminars include case studies to be solved and presented in groups. Seminars give 10% of the final grade.</p> <p>In order to receive maximum 10 points one should receive a “pass” grade from 1 out of 2 seminars. The “pass” grade requires that you contribute to your group work, your group tries to find a solution to the case study, presents the solution and is ready to answer questions.</p>
Written exam (E)	<p>Written exam will contain five questions. For the final grade the weighting for each question will be 20%. The questions will be either computing tasks or tasks that require a written analysis or qualitative assessment.</p> <p>For each questions the following scale is applied: (0-4 points) the question is not answered, or the answer shows that the student was not able to apply the correct approach for reaching the solution. (5-8 points) The method used for the solution is correct, but the question is solved only in minimum part, or with relevant conceptual mistakes. (9-14 points) The method used is correct, the solution is partly reached, but with some error(s). (15-20 points) the method used is correct, the solution to the question is also correct, or the student shows a deep and clear understanding of the method applied.</p>
ELIGIBILITY FOR ASSESSMENT	<p>In order to qualify for the final assessment, one has to receive “pass” grade from at least two home assignments and from at least one seminar.</p>
FINAL MARK	<p>The final grade is calculated from the total points gained from home assignments, seminars and written exam: 25 points: Home assignments (“pass” grade in at least two assignments) 10 points: Seminars (“pass” grade in at least one seminar) 0 to 65 points: Written exam Final grade = KT + S + E</p> <p>The final grade will be assigned according to the following scale: 0 (failed): 0-50 points 1: 51-60</p>
