

ASSESSMENT METHOD	ASSESSMENT CRITERIA
Case study, all learning outcomes	<p>Assessment criteria for the case study. Each student has to choose a topic. Either from the predefined list or independently. The topic must be confirmed with the course leader. After topic selection and literature study each student must make an overview presentation (5 min), presenting the outline and literature. The feedback must be taken into account while preparing the final presentation. The final presentation (20 min) has to be made before submitting the written report. Written report must be at least 4 pages, using given template.</p> <p>The presentation gives 1/3 of the final grade, written report another 1/3. The grading is performed in a scale of 0-5.</p> <p>The following items are evaluated during the presentation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Response to the feedback received during the short presentation • Completeness and structure of the presentation • Preparedness • Quality of the slides • Ability to answer to the questions <p>The following items are evaluated in the written report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Thoroughness of the report • Used literature • Completeness and structure of the presentation
Oral exam, all learning outcomes	<p>Assessment criteria for the oral exam. The oral exam is organized as an individual discussion. The student must be able to manage basic terminology, should be able to explain basic concepts, methodologies and definitions. The student should be able to bring examples from real life.</p> <p>The oral exam gives 1/3 of the final grade (evaluated on a scale 05). The final grade is given as follows:</p> <p>„0“ - less than 2 points „1“ - 2 - 4 points „2“ - 5 - 7 points „3“ - 8 - 10 points „4“ - 11 - 13 points „5“ - 14 and more points</p>
