Lab assignments	<p>Assessment criteria for lab assignments. <i>Each student performs practical works. Defense of the results of works occurs in writing, after timely representation of correctly issued reports on works.</i> <i>Lab work is given a passing grade if:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <i>the student understands the material worked out in a practical work,</i> - <i>the student can solve the problems connected with the accomplished work.</i> <p><i>If works are not presented in time they can be defended on the individual arrangement basis</i></p>
Written exam, all learning outcomes	<p>Assessment criteria for written exam. <i>The exam is written, each student is given an individual assignment and a set of questions. The students have 60 minutes to do the exam. The student can get up to 100 points for the exam. After the initial grades are given he students have a right to continue the exam orally to explain his or her solutions and answers aswell as answer any additional questions. The final grade after the additional oral exam can be higher aswell as lower than the initial grade for the written exam.</i></p> <p><i>The grades given for the exam are as follows:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> „0“ - <i>less than 51 points</i> „1“ - <i>51-60 points</i> „2“ - <i>61-70 points</i> „3“ - <i>71-80 points</i> „4“ - <i>81-90 points</i> „5“ - <i>91 and more points</i>
