

<b>EVALUATION METHOD</b>	<b>EVALUATION CRITERIA</b>
<b>Home quizzes (K1-K5)</b> (to evaluate learning outcomes 1-2)	<i>Differentiating evaluation/grading</i> A multiple choice quizzes will be opened on the website accompanying the course. The maximum score of one home quiz is up to 2 points. The results depend on the proportion of answers correct for the quiz.
<b>Home assignment</b> (to evaluate learning outcomes 1-3)	<i>Differentiating evaluation/grading</i> Individual or group work will be provided for home assignments for up to 60 points. Home assignments are designed to evaluate learning outcomes 1-3. Depending on the assignment, one assignment can give 10-30 points and at least 30 points worth of home assignments are for group work.
<b>Written exam</b> (to evaluate learning outcomes 1 and 3)	<i>Differentiating evaluation/grading</i> Written exam to evaluate learning outcomes 1 and 3. The exam consists of multiple-choice questions and questions requiring short answers.
<b>PRECONDITIONS FOR FINAL EVALUATION</b>	Students have to get at least 35 points from home assignments to be allowed to take the exam which are also preconditions for final evaluation.
<b>FORMATION OF FINAL SCORE</b>	Home quizzes up to 10 points, home assignments up to 60 points, exam up to 30 points plus possible bonus points earned during the course. The total result will be converted into a grade, based on the following point intervals, on the condition that exam result is at least 50%: 0-50 points „0“; 51-60 points „1“; 61-70 points „2“; 71-80 points „3“; 81-90 points „4“; 91-... points „5“.
