

**EEM0062 Quality Management**

<b>ASSESSMENT METHOD A</b> Pre-exam assignments: application of quality management techniques for analysis of selected object, process and/or organization (solutions for two assignments to be selected from fixed list, individual or teamwork)	<b>ASSESSMENT CRITERIA</b> Assessment is based on rightness and profoundness of solution, and correctness of presentation. Assessment is based on scale up to 10 + 10 = 20 points.
<b>ASSESSMENT METHOD B</b> Course paper ( individual, topic to be confirmed by lecturer, usually connects short survey of an area of quality management with a corresponding case study)	<b>ASSESSMENT CRITERIA</b> Assessment is based on comprehensiveness and profoundness of text and its seminar presentation, their connection to knowledge presented in subject and correctness of presentation. Assessment is based on scale up to 40 points.
<b>ASSESSMENT METHOD C</b> Written examination paper, which includes short answers to questions-A concerning concepts, relationships, principles and checklists for methods/techniques discussed in lectures as well as their implementation areas and principles, plus questions-B of more synthetic type. Topics of questions in each questionnaire covers all subject matters and is formed using stratified sampling principle.	<b>ASSESSMENT CRITERIA</b> Assessment is based on scale up to 40 points (including questions-A 15 p, questions-B 20 p, general impression 5 p)
<b>PRECONDITIONS FOR ATTENDING FINAL ASSESSMENT</b>	None
<b>FORMATION OF FINAL MARK</b>	Total score of assessment components A and B, up to 20 + 40 + 40 = 100 points, from which the grade is derived as fixed by valid scale used in TUT (including pass threshold level 51 points).
