ASSESSMENT METHOD	ASSESSMENT CRITERIA
Lab assignments (practical side of learning outcomes)	<p>Assessment criteria for lab assignments. Each student is given individual assignments. Lab work is given a passing grade if</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the assignment is done correctly (everything is working properly); • the student is able to answer any additional questions the lab has been done and reported in time; • the results of the lab assignments are presented in the oral form. <p>The lab assignments must have a passing grade in order for the student to be able to take the exam.</p>
Individual presentation paper (all learning outcomes)	<p>Assessment criterion of individual presentation papers. The student have to answer in a good way to the questions of other students and the teacher. It gives 30% of exam</p>
Written exam (all outcomes)	<p>The final grade consists of the results of individual work and presentation and possible written work during the semester. In addition all the labs should be accepted as well.</p>
PREREQUISITES FOR FINAL ASSESSMENT (EXAMINATION)	<p>Accepted labs and presentations.</p>
