| <b>METHOD FOR ASSESSMENT</b><br>Writing exam | <b>ASSESSMENT CRITERIA</b><br>Student knows food analysis-related legislation, international standards, sampling and sample preparation methods, all methods and analytical instruments introduced during lectures and is able to decide on applying a method for specific purpose of the analysis. Student knows and applies statistical methods for data analysis. Two case studies need to be analysed in the writing exam. Student can explain why s/he chose specific method, not any other. |

| <b>METHOD FOR ASSESSMENT</b><br>Practical work defence | <b>ASSESSMENT CRITERIA</b><br>Oral defending of the practical work, where student has acquired terminology, methods, chemical and mathematical equations of the methods used, working principles of the used laboratory equipment, working in lab.<br><br>Practical works are considered to be defended if the student is able to answer teacher's questions on any aspect of the practical works with minimum help. S/he understands the principles of the practical works and is able to describe them, is also able to solve chemical equations and calculations used for work tasks. Student is familiar with the lab equipment and knows their working principles |
| <b>PREREQUISITE FOR THE ASSESSMENT</b>                 | Passing the practical works  |
| <b>FINAL GRADE</b>                                     | Practical works make 20% of the final grade  |

| <b>METHOD FOR ASSESSMENT</b><br>Report and oral defending (in teams) | <b>ASSESSMENT CRITERIA</b><br>Student knows how to read scientific papers, finds relevant information, compares and discusses the content of the articles. Student is able to work in teams for the report.<br><br>Content of the report, illustrative materials used and excellent preparation of the report. Presentation is in limited time-frame, logically structured, clearly presented and argued. Student is well-oriented in specific subject and skilfully answering questions arisen. |
