ASSESSMENT METHOD	ASSESSMENT CRITERION
<p>Group work in practice lesson (assessing learning outcomes 1-4)</p>	<p>Each group must deal with different types of practical assignments of project management.</p> <p>The maximum amount of points for the assignments is 15. In the assessment each member of the group will be granted the same amount of points.</p> <p>Depending on the difficulty level of the assignment, it is possible to get 1-3 points per assignment.</p>
<p>Written group work to be finalised at home (to assess learning outcome 2 and 3)</p>	<p>Each group must present a correctly formatted project charter and action plan to achieve the goal of the project. The result of the work must be presented in the last training session.</p> <p>The maximum amount of points is 25. In the marking process, all group members will be given the same amount. As an exception, 0 points will be given to the member who did not participate in doing the analysis, and whose name is left out from the title page of the work.</p> <p>The result is:</p> <p>„1 to 5 points“ Project charter and action plan are superficially compiled and several aspects have been left unnoticed. The presentation only focuses on a few details.</p> <p>„6 to 10 points“ Project charter and action plan are logical and mostly clearly traceable and understandable. Only a few minor errors occur against the logic of the project action plan. The presentation high-lights most of the important aspects for project execution.</p> <p>„11 to 15 points“ Project charter and action plan are logical and mostly clearly traceable. All important project charter components are clearly described. The presentation outlines all the important aspects for the project implementation.</p> <p>„16 to 20 points“ Project charter and action plan are logical and mostly clearly traceable and understandable. It has some minor aspects, that have gone unnoticed. The presentation outlines all important aspects, that are needed for the project implementation.</p> <p>„21 to 25 points“ The project charter and action plan are compiled in thorough detail. All charter components are described correctly and in detail. The presentation outlines all the different aspects to implement the project.</p>
<p>E Exam (E) (to assess learning outcome 1 and 5)</p>	<p>During a pre-determined period, the students will take a case-study multiple-choice exam, for which they will have 1 hour.</p>

	<p>30 multiple-choice questions must be answered based on the theory of project management and keeping in mind the case-study at hand.</p> <p>Each correct answer gives 2 points.</p>
ELIGIBILITY FOR ASSESSMENT	<p>Providing the group homework on time.</p>
FINAL MARK	<p>Final result = individual exam 60 points + group in class 15 points + group work as homework 25 points</p> <p>Final result is turned into mark 0 to 5: 0-50 points „0“; 51-60 points „1“; 61-70 points „2“; 71-80 points „3“; 81-90 points „4“; 91-100 points „5“</p>
