

# ITO8010 Sissejuhatus andmeanalüüsi (Introduction to Data Analysis)

## Evaluation criteria

1. Evaluation method: Final exam (evaluates all learning outcomes).

Written paper-based multiple-choice examination with practical and theoretical questions. Supplemental materials are allowed to use. Communication with other students is permitted.

2. Evaluation method: Paper-based multiple-choice examination. Correct answer vs. wrong answer. There is a rule that the last grade of the tests will be the official grade and one cannot use supplemental materials during the examination.

3. Final grade: Final grade (G) = 0,3 x participation (à 0,075 points) + 0,3 x independent assignments (à 0,15 points) + 0,4 x grade of the examination.

Prerequisites for grading:

- 1) If the student does not participate in the final examination, the final grade of the course will be NA (not taken).
- 2) To get a positive final grade, one must get at least grade 1 (at least 51 points) in the final examination.

4. The grading scale shall be as follows:

- "5" (excellent) 91-100
- "4" (very good) 81-90
- "3" (good) 71-80
- "2" (satisfactory) 61-70
- "1" (sufficient) 51-60
- "0" (poor) less than 51
