Written report	Student must compose 4 reports. Each report will be evaluated in scale 1-10 points.
Exam	<p>In exam student demonstrates that he/she</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - has an overview of the different processes in garment industry; - knows how to analyse different garment manufacturing processes; - knows the basic terms of quality management; - knows process improvement methods; - knows different quality requirements in different textile and garment manufacturing processes; - knows how to describe product quality and process quality - knows the main requirements for product making; - knows how to use different standards.
Exam (evaluates the expected results 1-6)	<p>There is an exam at the end of the course on the topics learned during the course. The exam consists of questions and test.</p> <p>The exam is being valued in 100 point scale.</p> <p>Grade “1” – 51-60 points Grade “2” – 61-70 points Grade “3” – 71-80 points Grade “4” – 81-90 points Grade “5” – 91-100 points</p>
