Analyses project	<p>Assessment criteria for the project. Analyze a project, one of the company's business process or model compared to cloud development technology.</p> <p>You can find metrics for measuring process efficiency. Describe and analyze this process.</p> <p>Describing the process, and you offer a solution. Presenting metrics, documentation and exchange of information between the original plan.</p> <p>The project can make a team. The maximum number of team members - 2</p> <p>The process must include a description of various aspects of the process, which must specify at least a minimum:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a business background, - involved parties, - main process flow description, content of the messages, - exception and failures description, - metrics and measurement. <p>Points in the assessment of the project:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Integrity of each document and the integrity of the process model - the structure of logic - that the document does not constitute an analysis of the controversy; - The originality of the processes descriptions able to justify the choices made. <p>The maximum score is 60 points for the project. Grade is common to the entire group</p>
Midterm test	Take place at 7. week. It consists of multiple choice questions and a description of the business process

Theory test	The theory test is made at the end of the semester. Involves lectures materials submitted under multiple-choice questions.
PREREQUISITES FOR ASSESSMENT	Examination is verbal, project members have to defend their project all together, and answer to additional questions regarding the project and theory.
Computing the final grade	<p>Students are evaluated on a 100-point scale.</p> <p>Points can be gathered from a course project (up to 90 points) and from answering examination questions (up to 10 points).</p> <p>The grades given for the exam are computed based on the following scale transformation:</p> <p>„0“ - less than 51 points „1“ - 51-60 points „2“ - 61-70 points „3“ - 71-80 points „4“ - 81-90 points „5“ - 91 and more points.</p>
