EVALUATION METHOD	EVALUATION CRITERIA
E-tests (5) in Moodle (evaluates the expected results 1-5)	Each e-test contains 15 questions on certain topic.
Essay/presentation (evaluates the expected results 1-5)	<p>Student has to write an essay on the certain topic. On the basis of the essay an oral presentation must be prepared.</p> <p>The essay has to meet the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the volume of the essay 12-15 pages; - the essay is on the certain topic; - the essay is formed correctly; - the essay is presented on time; - oral presentation is prepared on the basis of the essay. <p>If all the prior conditions are filled, the essay is passed.</p>
Practical works (evaluates the expected results 1-5)	<p>Practical works are passed if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • all the practical works are performed; • protocols of the practical works are reported on time; • protocols are formed according to the instructions; • protocols and practical works are orally defended. <p>Practical works are not passed if any of the following conditions are not filled.</p>
Exam (evaluates the expected results 1-5)	<p>There is an exam at the end of the course on the topics learned during the course. The exam consists of questions and test.</p> <p>The exam is being valued in 100 point scale.</p> <p>Grade “1” – 51-60 points Grade “2” – 61-70 points Grade “3” – 71-80 points Grade “4” – 81-90 points Grade “5” – 91-100 points</p>
PRECONDITIONS FOR EVALUATION	To take the final exam all the e-tests must be done, essay/presentation and practical works must be passed.
THE DEVELOPMENT OF FINAL GRADE	E-tests give 20%, practical works 30% and exam gives 50% of the final grade.
