In case of more specific and detailed knowledge and skills, insubstantial minor mistakes might occur.</p> <p>3) „C“ (3) (Good) –a good level of learning outcomes is achieved that is characterized by a purposeful use of knowledge and skills. In case of more specific and detailed knowledge and skills, the student is uncertain and imprecise.</p> <p>4) „D“ (2) (Satisfactory) –achieving a sufficient level of learning outcomes that is characterized by the ability to use knowledge and skills in ordinary situations; however, in unusual situations deficiencies and hesitation become apparent</p> <p>5) „E“ (1) (Poor) –achieving the most important learning outcomes at a minimum level that is characterized by a limited use of knowledge and skills under typical circumstances; however, in unusual situations, significant deficiencies and hesitation become apparent.</p> <p>6) „F“ (0) (Fail) –student has acquired knowledge and skills at a level below the minimum.</p>
