<p>Continuous assessment of studies, written exam, all learning outcomes</p>	<p><i>Assessment criteria for the exam</i></p> <p><i>The final grade is based on the results of continuous assessment with the following components and weights (basic points): tests on knowledge 40%, individual assignments 20%, and course teamwork project (differentiated in-team assessment) 40% of the final grade. Basic points are accounted in the range of 100p system.</i></p> <p><i>To be eligible for the final result based on the continuous assessment, a student has to pass the tests on knowledge, and successfully defend the course teamwork project.</i></p> <p><i>Bonus points can be earned for active and excellent work in class. The upper limit of bonus points used for final grading is 10% of the basic points.</i></p> <p><i>For tasks that are presented after the given deadline, basic points will be deducted with minus points (minus points have a negative value, and are a part of the basic points).</i></p> <p><i>Shall the assessment take place online, the student is obliged to use a camera, and provide identification upon the request of the instructor. If the student does not comply with the requirement, the instructor retains the right not to evaluate the task, and/or evaluate the course with the final result marked as „Absent“.</i></p> <p><i>The final grade is based on the results of continuous assessment (sum of basic and bonus points) according to the following grading scale:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>„0“ - less than 50 points</i> <i>„1“ – 50 - 60 points</i> <i>„2“ – 61 - 70 points</i> <i>„3“ – 71 - 80 points</i> <i>„4“ – 81 - 90 points</i> <i>„5“ - 91 and more points</i>
