<p>Pre-conditions for assessment</p>	<p>Active participation in practical work (attendance of at least 75%; independent tasks are submitted on time and a positive grade is granted for all the required works.</p>
<p>Formation of the final grade</p>	<p>The student receives a pass grade if he or she has performed an academic public speech, written an academic essay in the classroom, has passed an orthography test and completed all the required tasks.</p>
