

Assessment methods	Evaluation criteria
Learning outcome 1	
6 tests (multiple choice questions) based on textbook.	Maximum score for 6 tests: 48 points. Each test has time limit.
4 tests (multiple choice questions) based on texts of famous philosophers (original texts).	Maximum score for 4 tests: 15 points. Each test has time limit.
Learning outcome 2	
1. forum, where each student can raise philosophical questions and explain his/her point of view.	Forum post worthy maximum 6 points: (1) is at least 300 words long and (2) demonstrates student's philosophizing skills and ability to explain his/her conception. Maximum score: 18 points
2. forum, where each student can discuss some philosopher or philosophical text.	The text representing student's own thoughts should be at least 300 words long and demonstrate his/her competence and ability to explain his/her own thoughts. Maximum score: 6 points.
The final grade	There is no examination aside tests and forums. The grade will base on their scores. Maximum score is 87 points. 91%-100%: grade 5 81%-90%: grade 4 71%-80%: grade 3 61%-70%: grade 2 51%-60%: grade 1
