For more detailed and more specific knowledge and skills some non-substantive and non-conceptual errors may be encountered;</p> <p>«C» («3») – «good» – the attainment of the learning learning outcomes with a good level of knowledge and skills. For more detailed and more specific knowledge and skills, uncertainty and inaccuracy is revealed.</p> <p>«(D)» («2») means the «satisfactory» – the achievement of learning outcomes with an appropriate level of knowledge and skills, which are characterized by the use in typical situations, in exceptional situations the symptoms of deficiencies and uncertainties are encountered;</p> <p>«(E)» («1») „scarce“ means the the level of the minimum acceptable key – the achievement of learning outcomes with the knowledge and skills, which are characterized by the use in limited ways;</p> <p>«F» («0») means the «poor» means the student has gained knowledge and skills at a level below the minimum level.</p>
